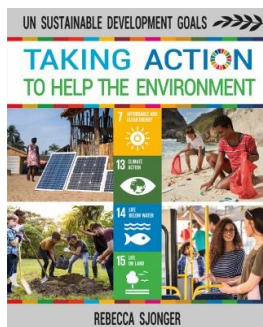
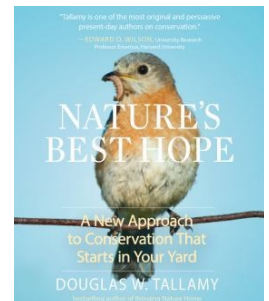
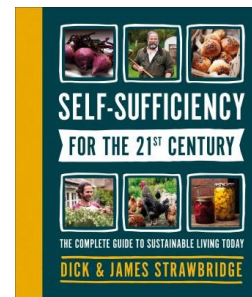
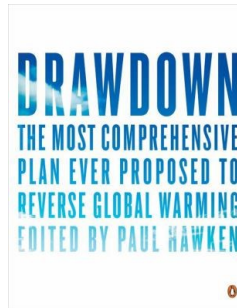
Books, DVDs and audiobooks on sustainability topics

include magazines, guides, pamphlets, and documents

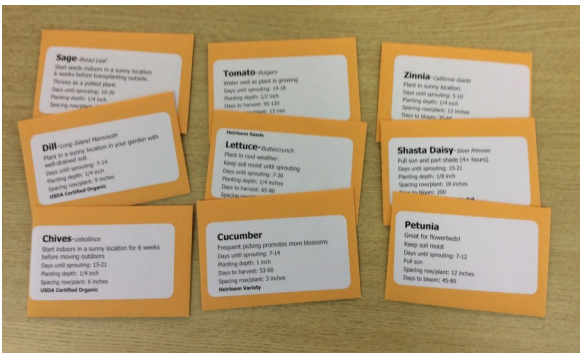
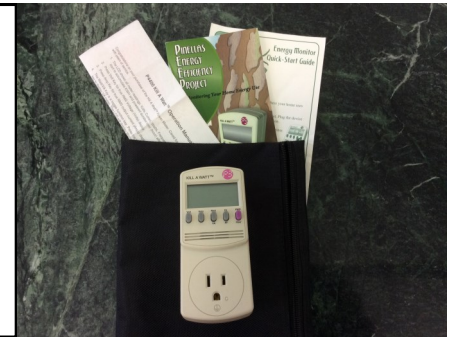
Publications are searchable in the online catalog (**tarponlibrary.org**)

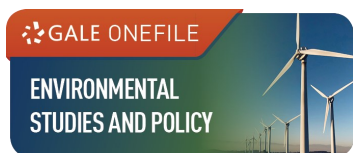
