#### TARPON SPRINGS HERITAGE MUSEUM

#### 1883 SAFFORD HOUSE MUSEUM

Surrounded by vintage Victorian homes in the Golden Crescent neighorhood, the Safford House, is a fine example of late 19th century Florida vernacular architecture. Your visit is a journey back in time more than 130 years ago to the home of Tarpon Springs' founders- Anson P.L. Safford.
